From analysing the data it can be seen that there are only 2 non swimmers in the Starfish ability group, with them just wearing a backfloat and 1 armband. The 31 children in the Stingray and Dolphin ability groups all achieved 25m swims, making 55% of the higher ability groups capable of swimming without any flotation aids and very confident in the water. In all ability groups the children were introduced to all four strokes, frontcrawl, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly and performed and engaged in a total of 90 minutes in self rescue techniques. All children have achieved a minimum of 10m swims.

As a school and working alongside Swimstars and Dolphins we aim to increase the percentage of swimmers achieving a minimum of 25m to 95% for the April - July term.
